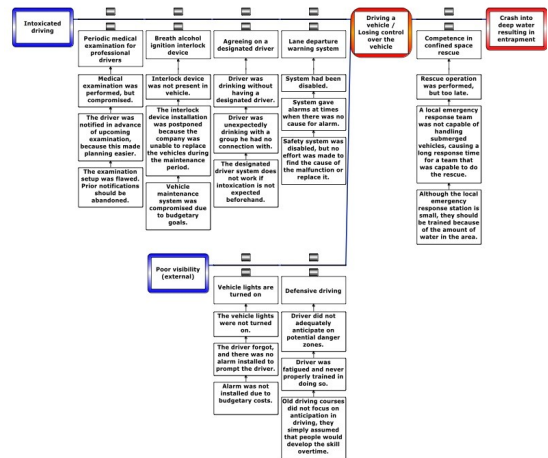


## Incident/Accident Investigator Training
